### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would implement lower-cost elements of the federally funded Willamette Blvd Active Transportation Corridor scheduled for construction in 2025-2026.

These near-term improvements would include new marked crosswalks, improved bus stops, and new buffered bike lanes from N Alma Ave to N Richmond Ave.

In order to facilitate these changes, on-street parking would be removed in this section of N Willamette Blvd.

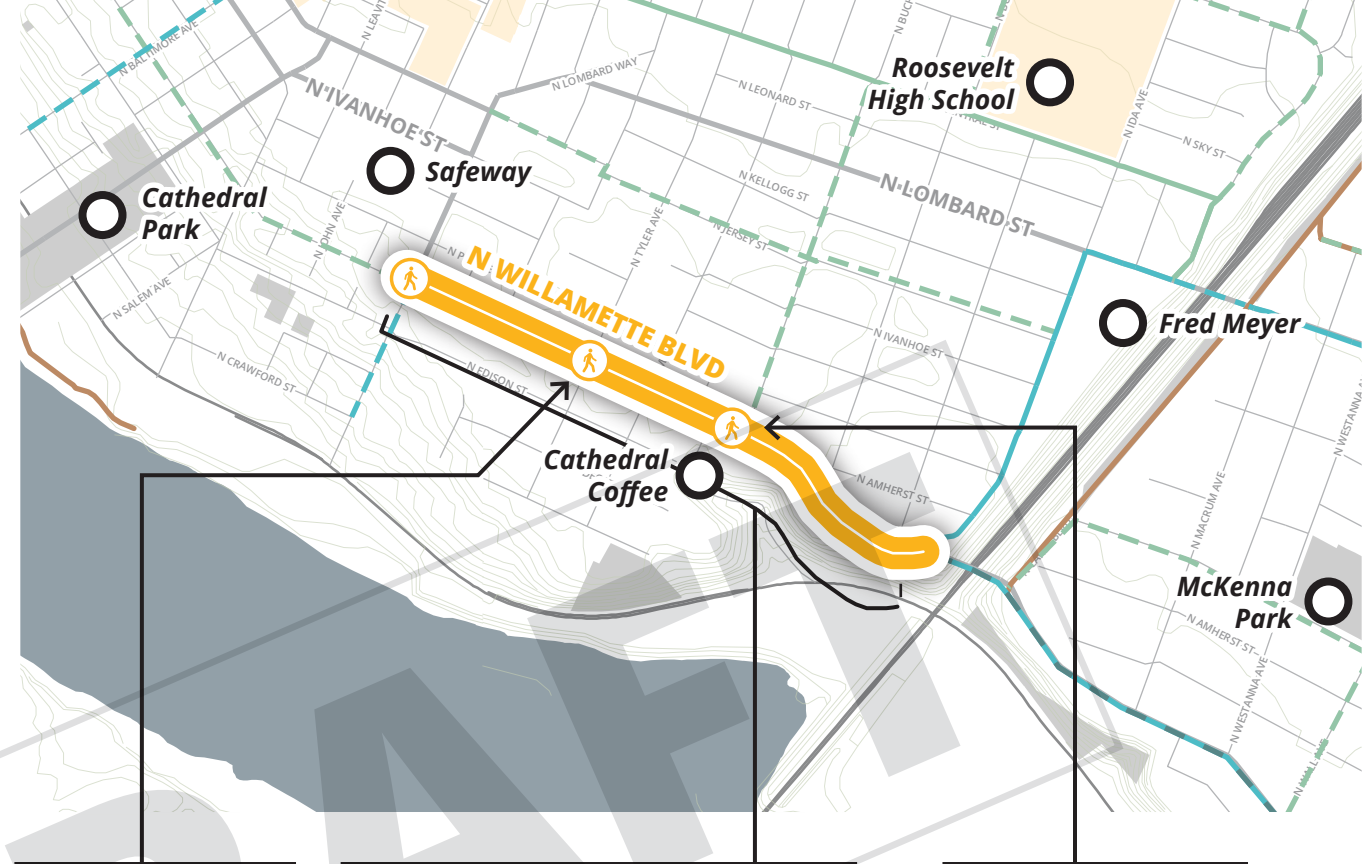

*Early implementation of buffered bike lanes on N Willamette Blvd from N Alma Ave to N Richmond Ave (to be upgraded with physical protection through the federally-funded N Willamette Blvd project by 2026)*

*Fix irregular curb-line and add ADA curb ramps at N Edgewater Ave; add new marked crossing at N Buchanan Ave*
