While PBOT continues to be impacted by the nation-wide wood pole shortage, the project has secured four wood poles that can be installed within the next few months. We are in the process of arranging tree trimming, scheduling installation of new wood poles, and coordinating with PBOT maintenance crews to relocate signs.
