Dear Kristan:

The NWDA Planning Committee has reviewed the correspondence and documents regarding the above referenced proposal at several meetings since March of this year, and at its meeting on September 26th, and took the action below:

**By Resolution:** The NW District Association supports the following allocations of NWPD funds for existing projects and programs for the budget year 2025-26 conditioned as noted below:

1. Temporary implemented Tier 1 projects area assessed for effectiveness before consideration of being made permanent;
  - a. assessment of the significant changes now apparent in commuter and visitor behavior;
  - b. clear before and after data assessment on all installed projects;
  - c. current relevant data informing all new installations;
2. Proposed new projects to have specific neighborhood buy-in/approval of the actual design of proposed new installations.
3. Allocation of NW Parking District funds are clarified as to specific projects;
4. Pedestrian streetlighting on NW 21<sup>st</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> to be acknowledged by the NWPD as the priority capital improvements project for Northwest Portland.
