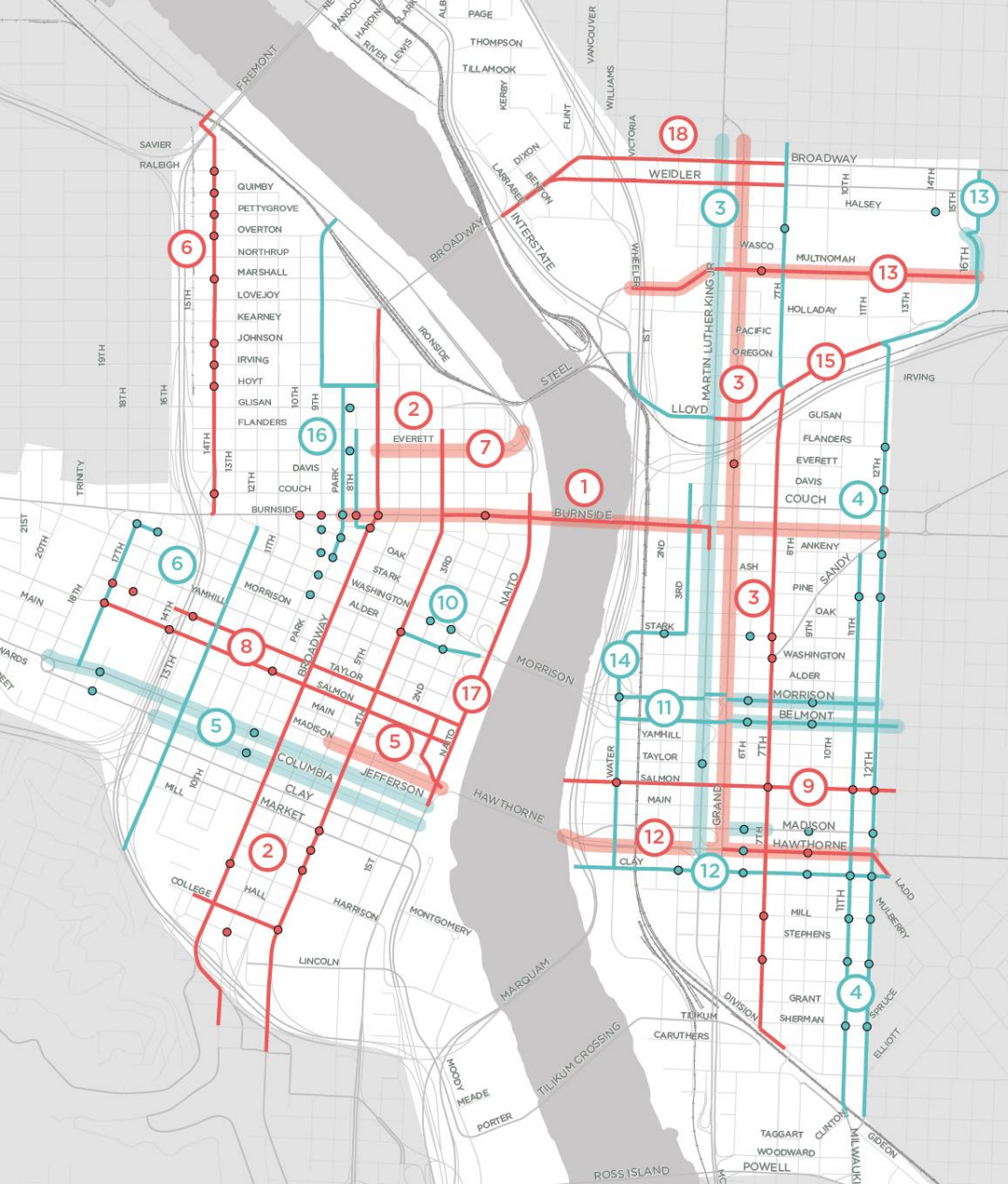


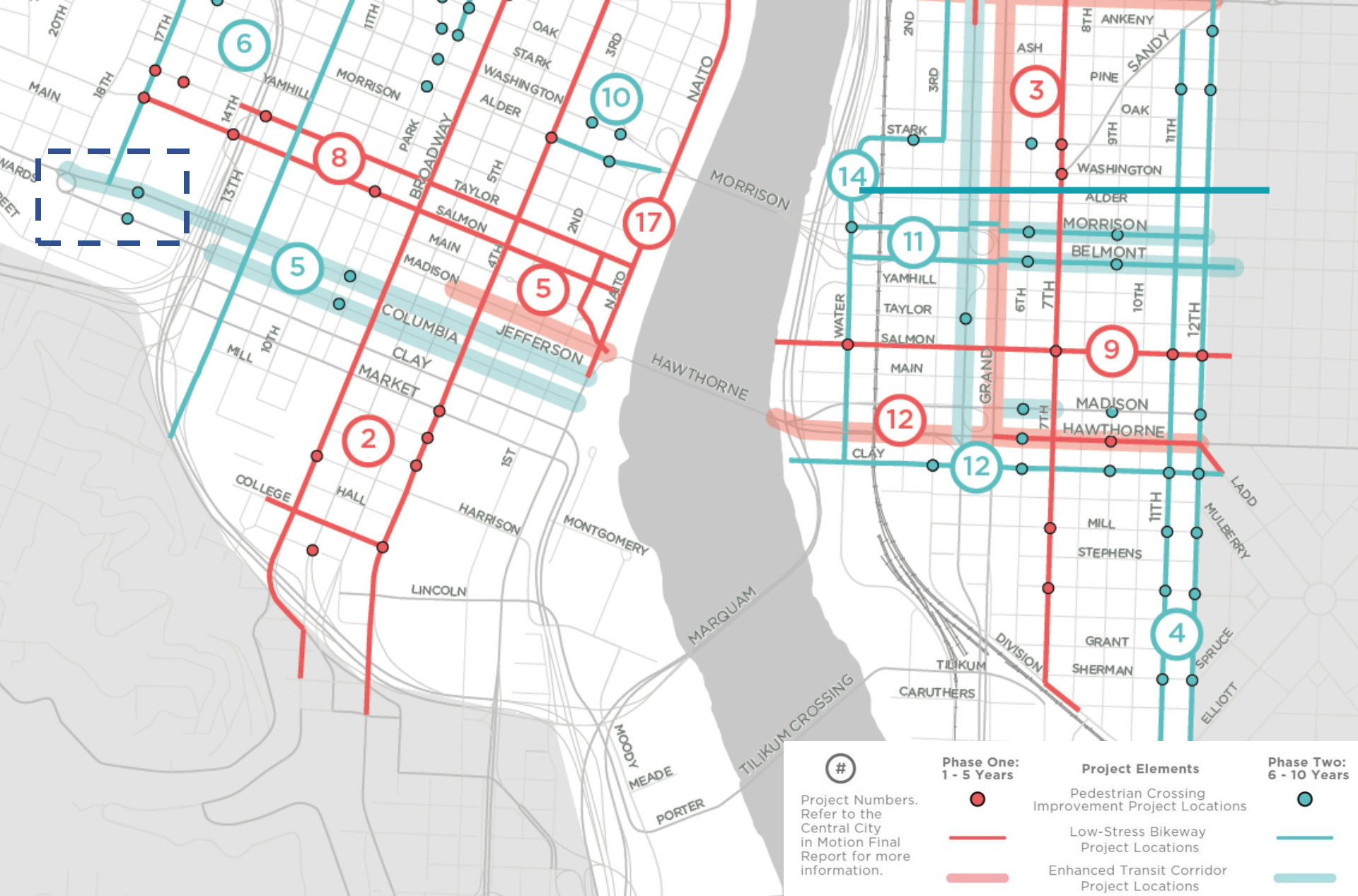

CENTRAL CITY IN MOTION

Central City in Motion is PBOT's effort to plan, prioritize, and implement transportation improvements in the city's core.

Eighteen projects were prioritized through this planning effort. They include new pedestrian crossings, bus lanes, and bikeways.





Project Goals



Improve transit speed and reliability

- Bus lines served: 6, 45, 58, 68
- The existing infrastructure creates long queues in the through / left-turn lane for buses heading west (6, 68)



Improve bicycling comfort and safety

- Bike lane in door zone. Mixing zone approaching 18th

Initial Designs



Current status

- Exploring feasibility of a concrete transit island at 17th
- Serve the 6 and 68
- Shortens crossing distance for pedestrians at 17th allows bike lane to stay along the curb
- Next steps: Traffic modeling, signal timing, construction estimate
- Anticipated construction: Fall 2021
