(2.1) PLAN OVERVIEW

The Portland Bureau of Transportation is developing a plan for 122nd Ave and project to be built in 2020.

Potential changes include safety improvements, more crossings, improved bike lanes, bus lanes, and signal changes to support frequent bus service along this essential multimodal corridor.

Plan Goals


- Increase safety for all, improve pedestrian & bicycle access and support better transit while balancing needs of freight & other modes.
- Identify improvements to help eliminate serious injuries and fatalities and remove 122nd Ave from the Vision Zero High Crash Corridor network

Outcomes

- Develop a multi-modal conceptual investment plan.
- Identify any street cross-section changes.
- Apply the Enhanced Transit Toolbox to improve transit capacity, reliability and speed.
- Identify a subset of priority project improvements to build with the roughly \$2.2M of Fixing Our Streets program funds for 122nd Ave in 2020, and \$1.1M additional funding secured (total project funding is \$3.3M).
- Identify other recommended improvements for future projects to seek funding.


