


# Short-term critical safety fixes

Add bike boxes, stop bars and cross-bike markings

High visibility crosswalks (Complete)

School speed zone (Complete)

Install warning sign with future upgrade to electronic sign

Pedestrian/Bike head start

Tighten radius of southeast corner (Complete)

Remove overgrown vegetation

Add green bike lanes with buffer

# Mid-term to long-term shared work

Evaluate freight classifications and truck routing on SE 26th Avenue

Work with ODOT to figure out cost of jurisdictional transfer that achieves "state of good repair" and a safe inner Powell

Upgrade signals to allow pedestrian/bike head start at all signals on Powell



New pedestrian crossing with refuge island at Cleveland entrance

Permanent speed feedback signs and speed cameras on Powell

Elevate bike lane to increase separation
