Project Summary

Portland's Bureau of Transportation, Bureau of Environmental Services, and Water Bureau are working in coordination to improve the street, stormwater, and water systems on SW Capitol Highway.

This project will provide new walkways and bikeways, manage stormwater, and upgrade the water system along SW Capitol Highway between SW Garden Home and SW Taylors Ferry Roads. The east side of Capitol Highway will feature a new sidewalk and protected bike lane; the west side of the road will include a paved multi-use path. Four large stormwater facilities off of SW Capitol Highway will collect and treat storm runoff from the project area, helping reduce flooding and erosion issues. A new water main will be installed on SW Capitol Highway north of SW Marigold Street, and on two blocks of SW Carson Street.

Schedule and Detours

The city's contractor, Landis & Landis Construction LLC, plans to start setting up construction zones the first week of June. Construction will start at the north end of the project near SW Multnomah Boulevard. Work in other areas of the project, such as tree trimming and excavation along SW Capitol Highway, is likely to begin shortly thereafter. The contractor also will be setting up a materials staging site at the Sears Armory on SW Multnomah Boulevard near SW 25th Avenue. A more detailed construction schedule will be available at the online open houses June 10.

SW Capitol Highway will be closed to southbound traffic from SW Garden Home Road to SW Taylors Ferry Road for most of the 18-month project. Southbound traffic from Multnomah Village, including TriMet buses, will be rerouted westbound on SW Garden Home Road and/or SW Multnomah Boulevard, southbound on SW 45th/48th Avenues, and eastbound on SW Taylors Ferry Road to return to SW Capitol Highway near I-5 (see map). Northbound traffic and TriMet buses will remain on SW Capitol Highway throughout the project, with occasional closures of individual bus stops. A pedestrian route will be maintained on SW Capitol Highway. This detour helps the contractor construct the SW Capitol Highway improvements in a more safe and efficient manner. Shorter-term detours are possible on SW Garden Home Road, SW 40th Avenue, and SW Carson Street.

Property vehicle access will be maintained throughout the project, except for short durations when driveways are being reconstructed. We will provide several days advance notice of any such closures, as well as any temporary utility shutoffs.

What to Expect During Construction



Workers will trim trees prior to construction.



Mail, garbage, and delivery services will have access.



Southbound traffic will be detoured. Expect traffic delays.



Construction creates noise and dust.



Several days advance notice will be given for driveway reconstruction and temporary utility shutoffs.

Funding

The project is funded by PBOT's Fixing Our Streets program, transportation system development charges, Bureau of Environmental Services funds, Water Bureau funds, and the Oregon Lottery.
