Multnomah Walkways

A safer walkway and bikeway from SW 37th Ave to SW 40th Ave





Project Overview

The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) is designing improvements to SW Multnomah Blvd from SW 37th Ave to SW 40th Ave. The project will restripe the existing paved space to provide an interim safer shoulder walkway and bikeway along the north side of the street, offer physical separation for pedestrians and people bicycling, and clarify legal turning movements to and from adjacent businesses and residences.

The route will fill a critical sidewalk gap along SW Multnomah Blvd and improve safety for people walking, rolling, and bicycling. This project is currently in the design phase. Construction is expected by 2024.

Project Background




