**6:00-6:15: Welcome & Introductions** (15 mins)

**Meeting point:** The northwest corner of 82nd and Division Street at 6 P.M.

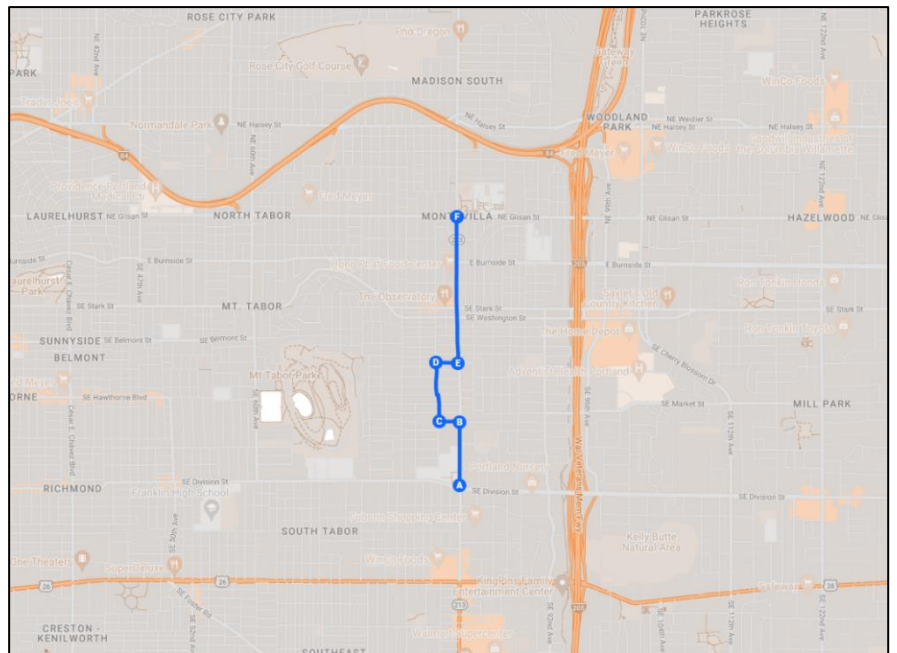
**6:15-7:30: Walking Tour** (approx. 75 mins)

**Walking route:** Once the group has convened, we will walk north on 82nd Ave and hear from Building a Better 82nd planning staff on upcoming projects along the corridor.

At SE Mill Street the group will turn west and see a newly built streetscape project, then walk northbound on SE 80th Ave for a few blocks to hear about an upcoming bikeway project.

At SE Taylor Court, the group will walk eastbound and connect back to 82nd Avenue, where we will continue walking north to NE Glisan Street and catch the bus 72 back to our meeting point.

PBOT will provide bus tickets for the walking meeting. If needed, we can end the walk at E. Burnside and take the bus back from there. The entire route is about a 1.8 mile walk, or 36 minutes without stops.
