The Portland Bureau of Transportation’s (PBOT) [Healthy Businesses](#) permit allows temporary changes to streets, sidewalks, and parking spaces to give people more space to conduct business safely amid our current public health crisis. Public right-of-way space (streets, sidewalks, and/or parking spaces) may be used for people or vehicles lining up, restaurant tables and chairs, waiting areas, retail space, temporary patio or plaza, or other services and creative uses.

Community-led [public plazas](#) are another component of PBOT’s Covid-19 response framework. In 2021, PBOT supported numerous public plazas around the city in partnership with local organizations, businesses, and communities.

PBOT staff will brief the PAC on the next phase of these street activation programs in Portland.
