
SE Powell & 26th short-term improvements:

Pedestrian head start (21st, 26th, 28th) (complete, bike signs to come @26th)


Tighten radius of southeast corner with bumps and edgeline (complete)

Mid-term to long-term work

Evaluate freight classifications and truck routing on SE 26th Avenue

- Look more comprehensively at freight classifications and routing in summer 2023
- Use data and policy driven approach to determine appropriate interventions
- Will engage with stakeholders as part of the process

PBOT and ODOT collaborating on a cost of jurisdictional transfer that achieves "state of good repair" and basic safety

- Planning to have a shared estimate or a range in April 2023
- ODOT evaluating road reorganization to reduce number of lanes on Powell

New pedestrian crossing with refuge island at Cleveland High School entrance

PBOT is conducting project development for this crossing and determining the crossing design and cost

Permanent speed feedback signs and speed cameras on Powell

• ODOT and PBOT have identified viable locations for the speed cameras and are working through design and permitting. Permanent speed feedback signs associated with the cameras will replace temp signs.

Update signals to allow pedestrian/bike head start at all signals on Powell

PBOT and ODOT are working through these signal changes over the next year

Consider elevating bike lane on SE 26th to increase separation

PBOT will evaluate the feasibility and benefits of this design in next fiscal year (23-24)

School Zone review

PBOT and ODOT collaborating to identify other high schools within Portland for School Speed 20 signs.

TriMet Line 70 re-route

TriMet planning to re-route Line 70 to use Powell Blvd, 21st Ave, and Ladd Ave starting in Spring 2023
