Re.: NOTICE OF PROPOSED SEIZURE OF VESSEL BLUE BAYLINER ON TRAILER CASE 2022-31065

A blue Bayliner boat and trailer with was issued a pre-seizure notice by the Portland Bureau of Transportation Parking Enforcement Division (Enforcement Agency) on November 17, 2022 for parking illegally in the public right-of-way, in violation of [Portland City Code 16.20.170](#) at the approximate location of 6600-6649 N ARMOUR ST. This notice is being issued in accordance with ORS 830.918 because the boat is considered an "Abandoned vessel" as defined in ORS 830.908 (1) and has been left without authorization on public or private land, the waters of this state, or any other water.

The enforcement agency will seize the vessel 10 days after this notice, by reason of being an abandoned vessel, a derelict vessel, or both. The owner will be liable for the costs of salvage, towing and storage of the vessel. Once the vessel is seized, it may be destroyed or sold if the costs of salvage, towing, storage, and disposal are not paid and is not claimed.

An owner of a vessel may request a hearing before an enforcement agency seizes a vessel under ORS 830.908 by submitting a request for hearing to the enforcement agency not more than 10 business days after the notice required by this section is given. The request must indicate if the owner contends that the vessel is not abandoned or derelict or indicate such other specific grounds on which seizure of the
