

Portland Bicycle Counts

Each summer, over 100 Portlanders come together to count people biking at more than 300 locations across the city. This volunteer-powered effort, coordinated by the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT), gathers valuable data about biking in Portland—who is biking, where, and how it's changing over time.

For over 30 years, Portland has conducted these bike counts, making it the longest-running annual bike count in the country. This initiative has become a beloved tradition in a city known for its enthusiasm for bicycles.
