



# FREE STREET TREES

from Portland Parks & Recreation's Urban Forestry and  
Portland's Tree Planting and Preservation Fund

SEPTEMBER 15, 2022

Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) will plant free street trees next to the property listed above from November 2022 to March 2023. Trees will be planted in the public right-of-way between the curb and sidewalk. This area is City property. Locations are marked on the curb in white paint. Sites were selected to avoid utility conflicts and provide 20-25 feet spacing between trees.

**PP&R will plant, water, and care for the trees through October 2025.** After this time, the adjacent property owner will be responsible for any further tree maintenance under Portland City Code 11.60.060.A.2.a.

**Why are we planting trees?** This neighborhood has a high need for additional tree canopy. Carefully selected street trees provide many services, including shade, cooling, reduced air and noise pollution, stormwater absorption, more walkable neighborhoods, slower traffic speeds, stress reduction, and beauty. Trees are funded by Portland's Tree Planting and Preservation Fund, which is used to plant trees to compensate for those removed in property development and other situations.

**To receive free street trees,** no action is required. If you do not decline by Monday, October 17, 2022, trees will be planted next to your property.

**!** **To decline free street trees,** the property owner must contact PP&R Urban Forestry by **Monday, October 17, 2022.**
