When do I need to submit a Street Tree Permit Application - Non-Removal?

You will need to submit a Street Tree Permit Application - Non-Removal when <u>no development is occurring</u>, and you want to do one or more of the following:

- Plant a street tree
- Prune a street tree without inspection
 - o Available when the following conditions are met:
 - Pruning is for branches less than 6" in diameter at attachment to the stem.
 - Pruning is for young tree pruning, crown cleaning or crown raising for clearance of the street and sidewalk (7.5' above the sidewalk, 11' above residential streets, and 14' over arterial streets).
 - The street tree is not a Heritage Tree.
- Any other work on street trees not specified in an existing permit application

A **street tree** is any tree located in the City right-of-way, typically in the planting strip between the sidewalk and the curb. Unimproved right-of-ways that do not have a sidewalk and/or a curb may also contain street trees.

Street tree permit applications may require an on-site inspection by an Urban Forestry Tree Inspector.

Street Tree Permit Application, Non-Removal Instructions

- 1) Fill out the attached application completely and legibly. All information is required for the application to be deemed complete and processed. Incomplete applications are subject to delays.
- 2) Submit the completed application in **one** of the following ways:

- 3) There is no application fee for the Street Tree Permit Non-Removal application.
