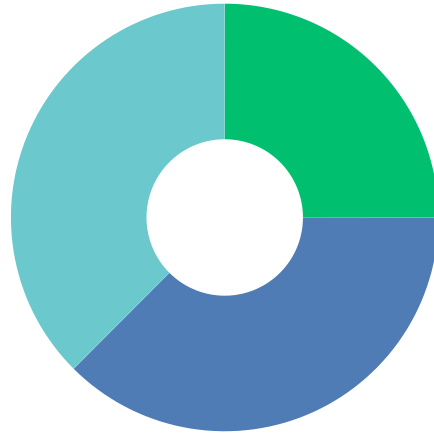


Q1 Looking at the sample images above, do you like or dislike the playful industrial architectural style?

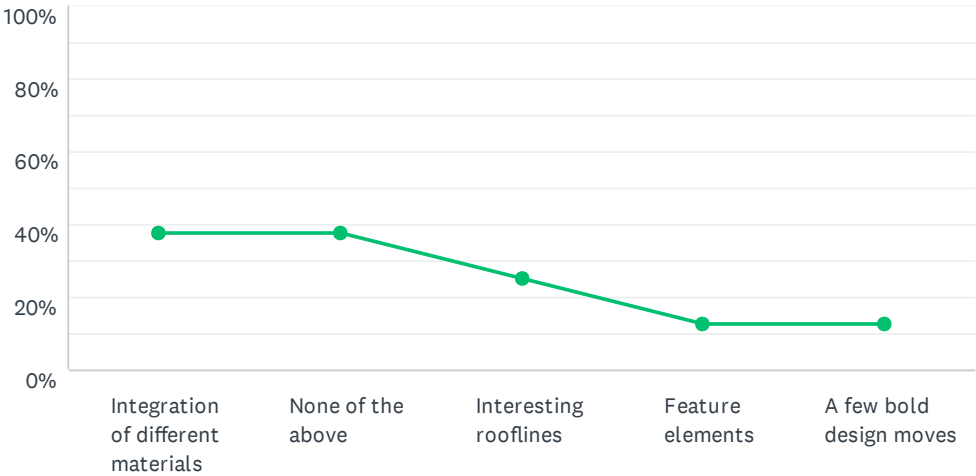

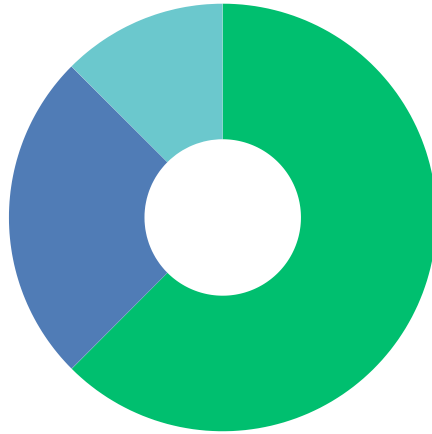

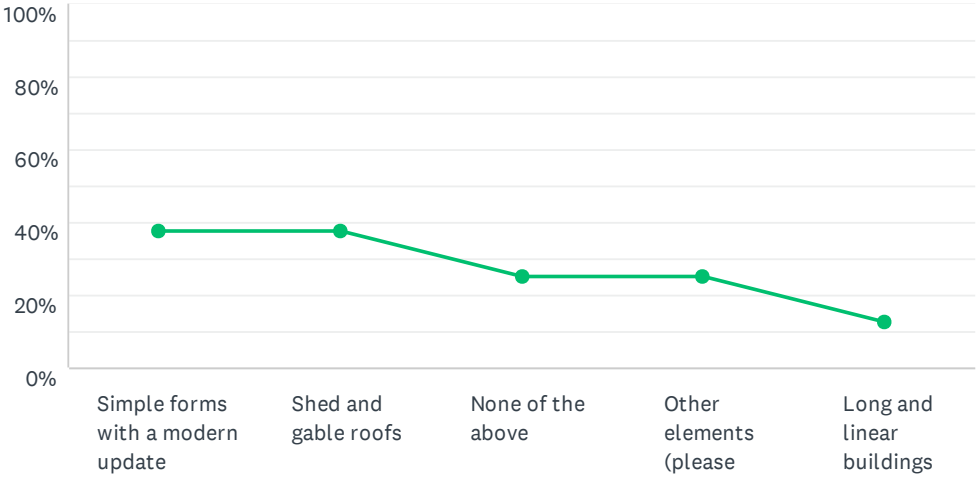

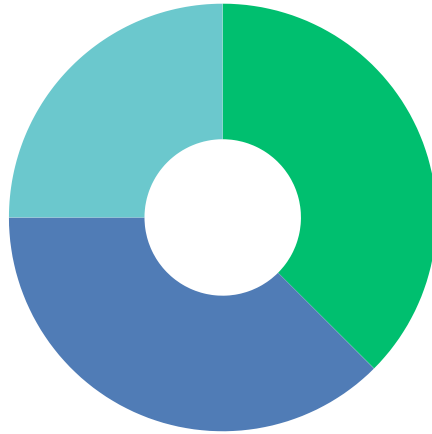

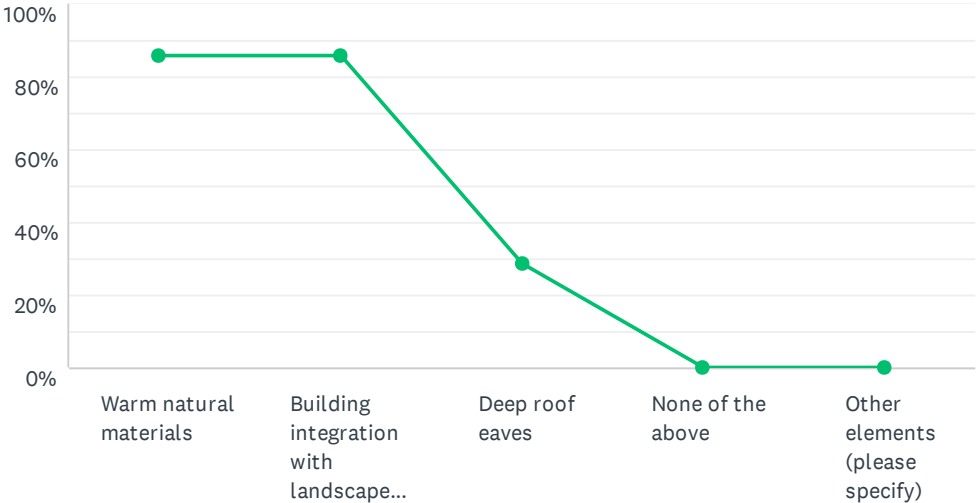

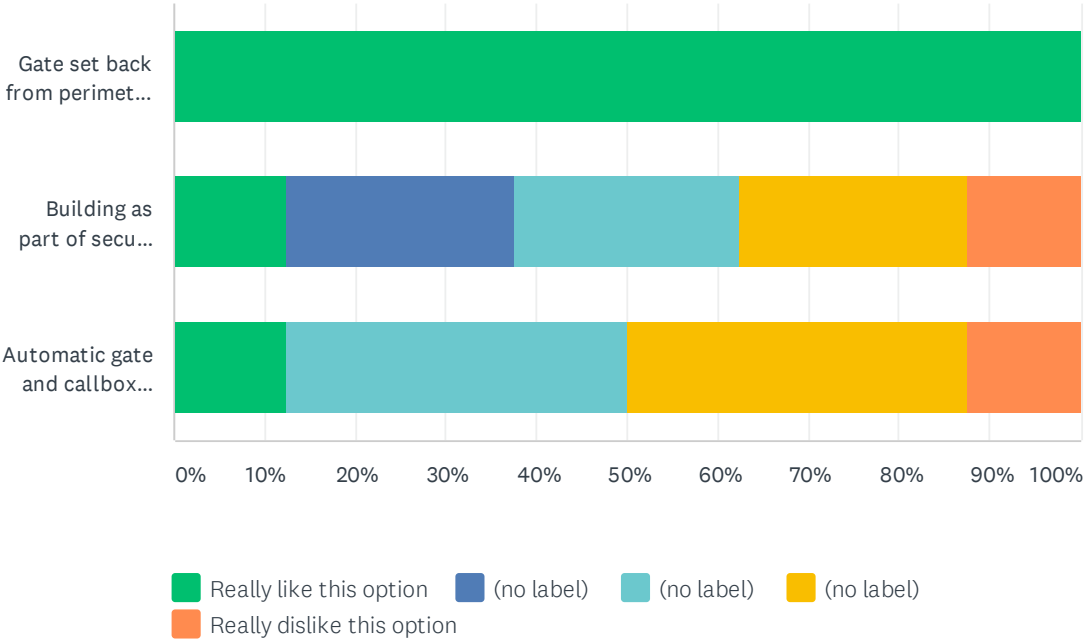

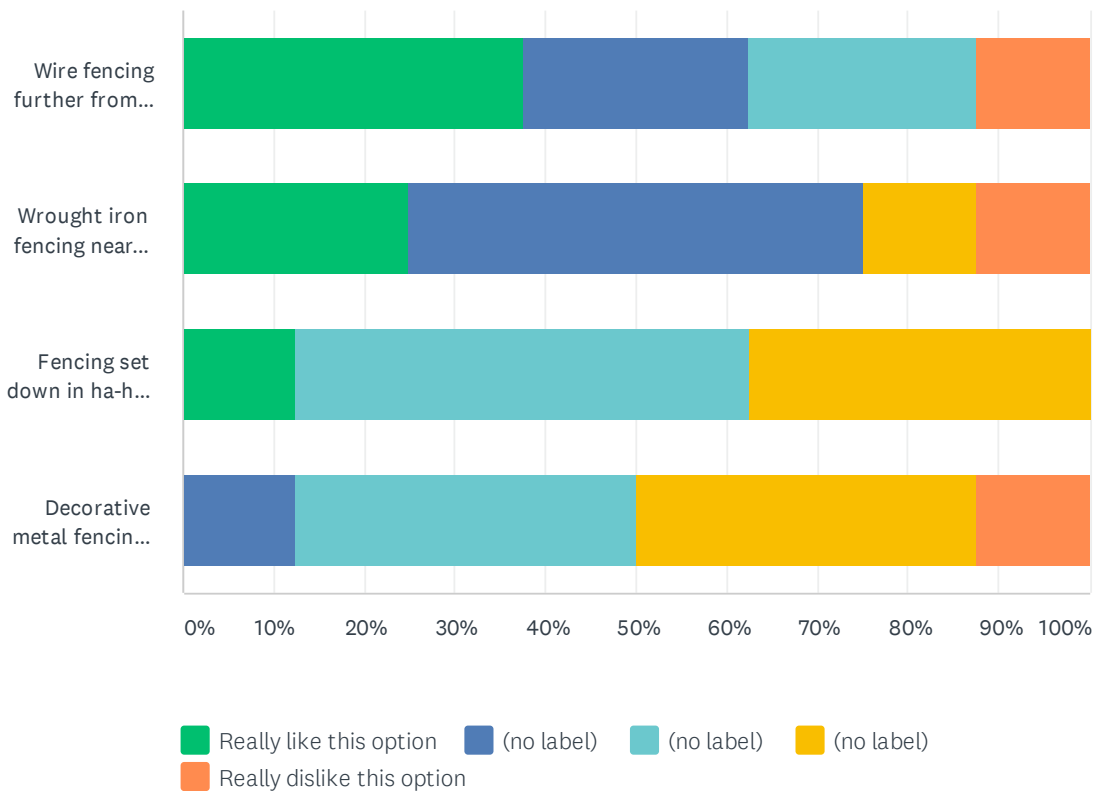
