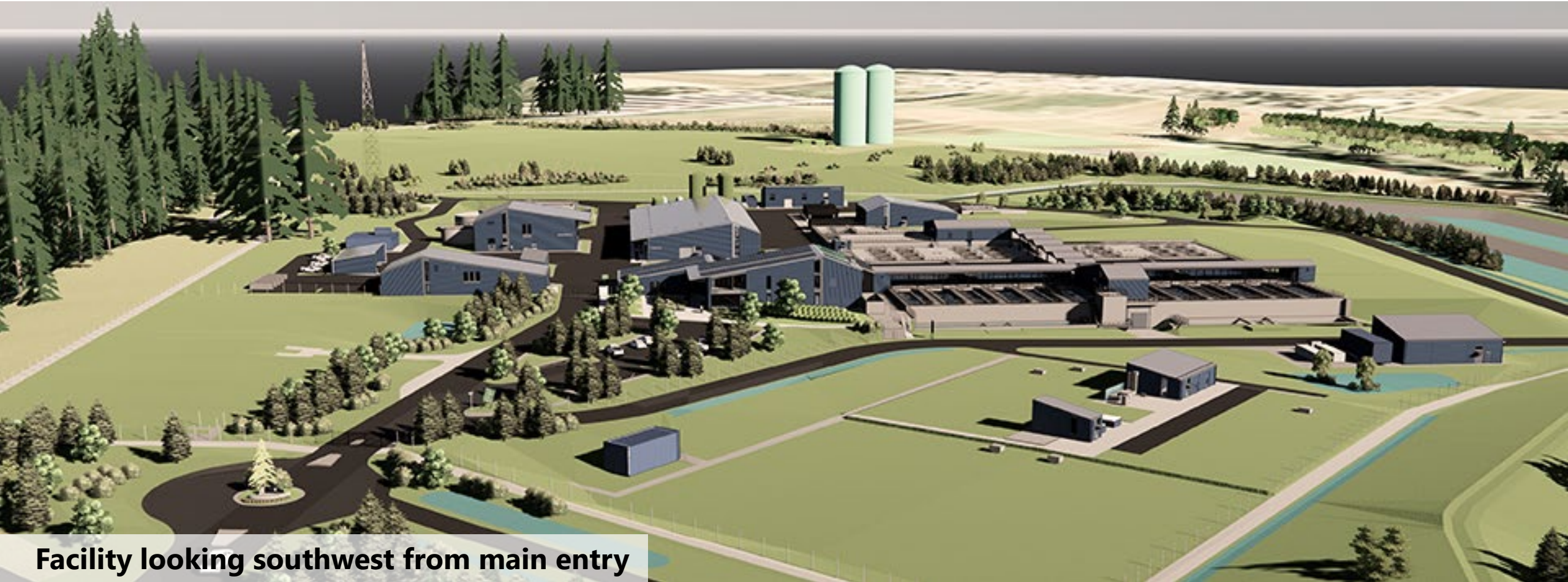

Facility looking southwest from main entry

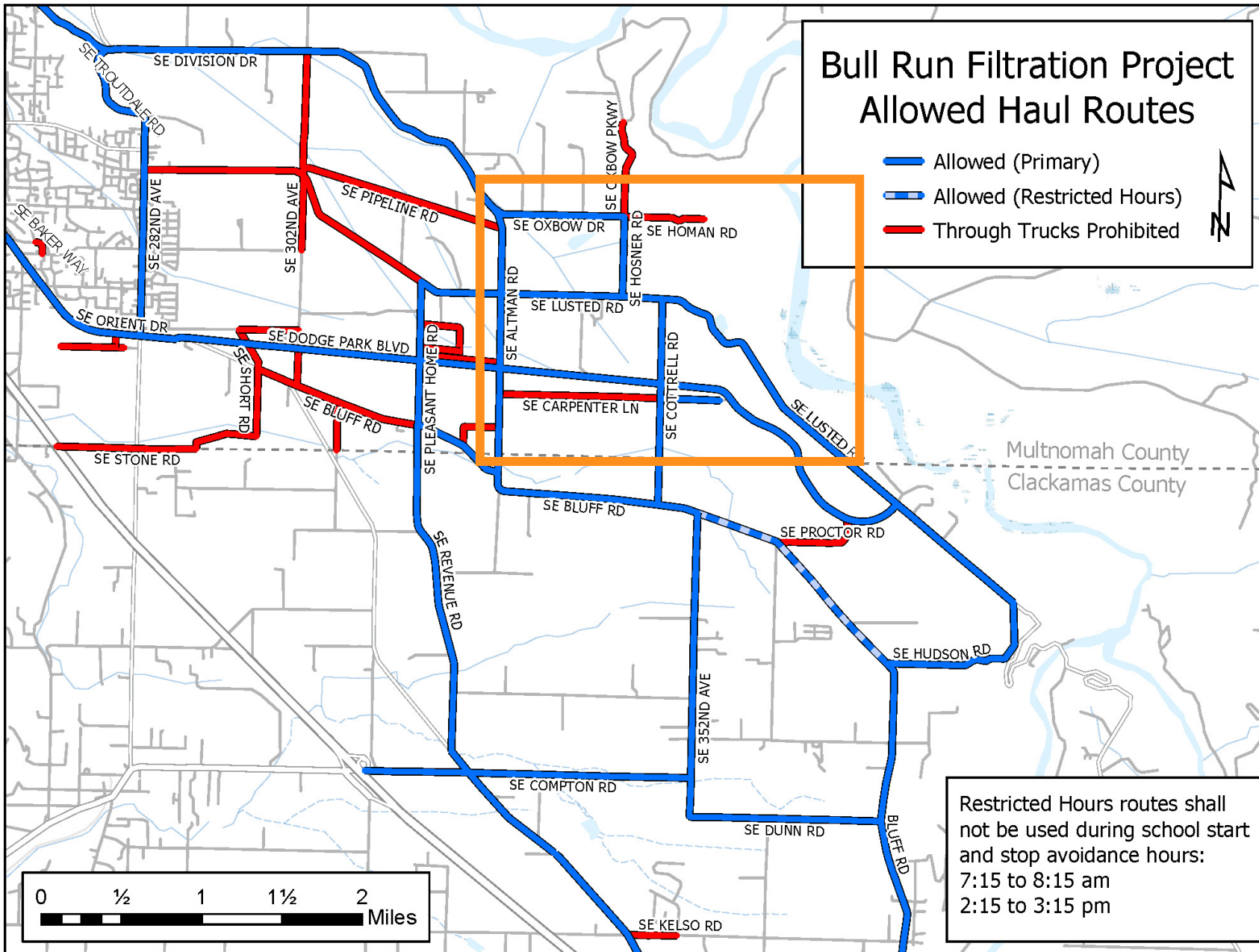
Project overview



Bull Run Filtration project update

- Obtained land use permitting re-approval from Multnomah County in June
- Anticipating construction site activity will be fully ramped back up this month
- Typical hours will be Monday through Saturday to help make up the delay
- Preparing for start of additional project area roadway improvements
- Ongoing communication and outreach to facility site neighbors and local businesses

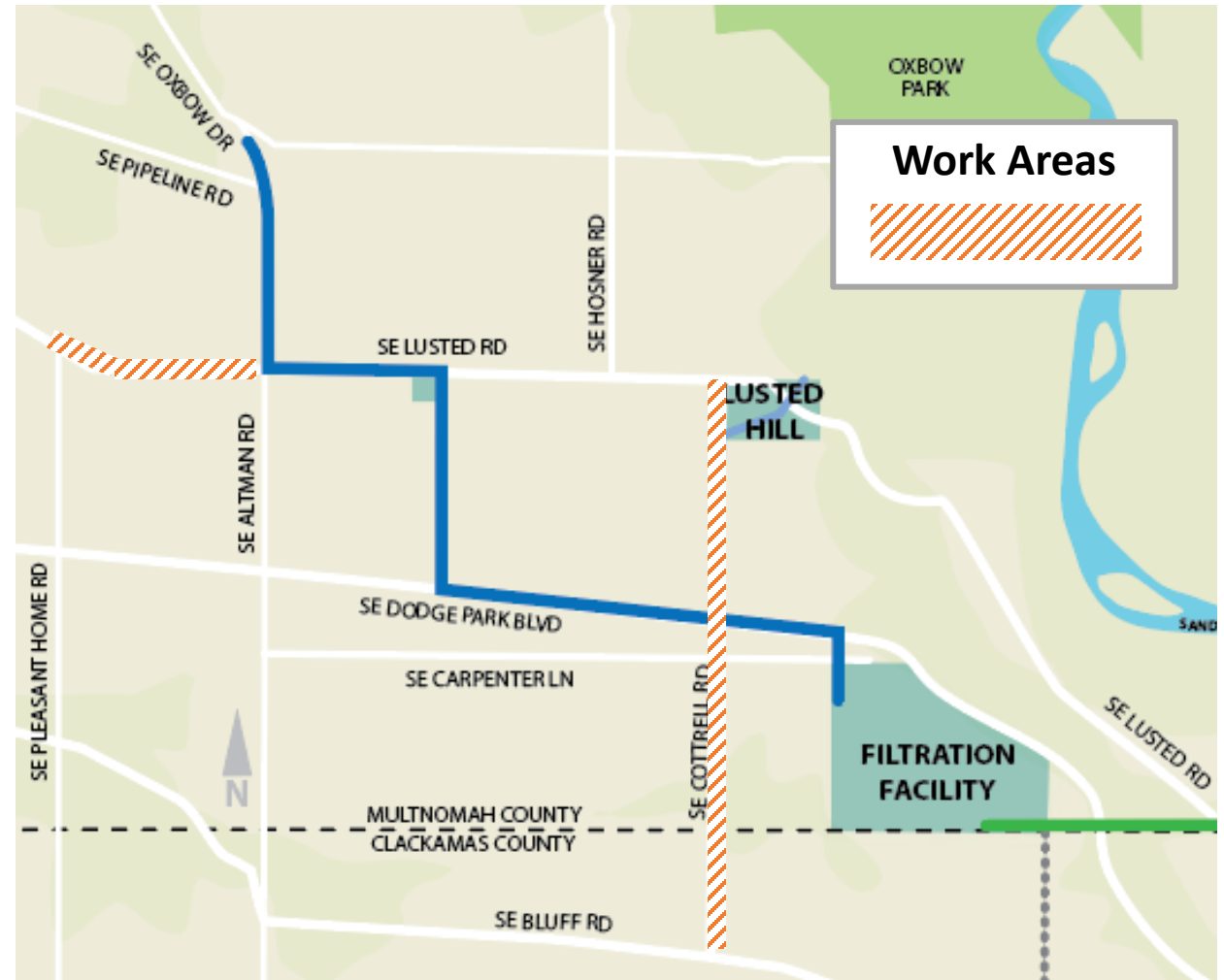




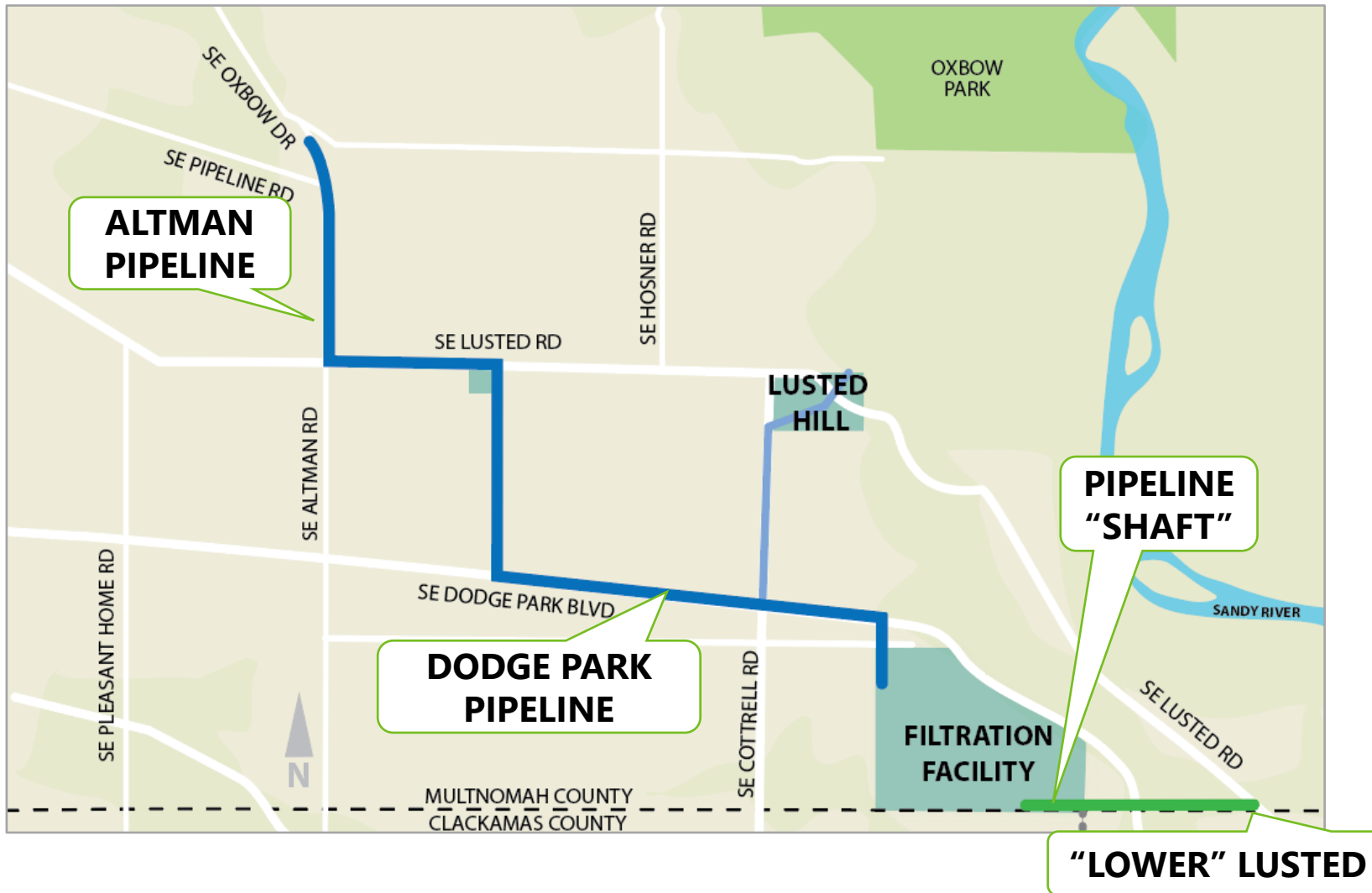
- Project construction truck traffic is using allowed haul routes
- Haul routes are signed
- Contractors will continue to monitor and maintain condition of these roads (**within orange box**) as needed in coordination with Multnomah County

Project area road surface improvements

- Planning to repave Lusted Road (between Altman and Pleasant Home) in late August
- Planning to repave Cottrell Road (between Lusted and Bluff) in September
- These roads are designated as haul or detour routes for construction traffic



Pipeline construction overview



Raw Water Pipelines:

- Two new pipes will tie in at "lower" Lusted with existing conduits, then tunnel uphill to shaft at facility site

Finished Water Pipelines:

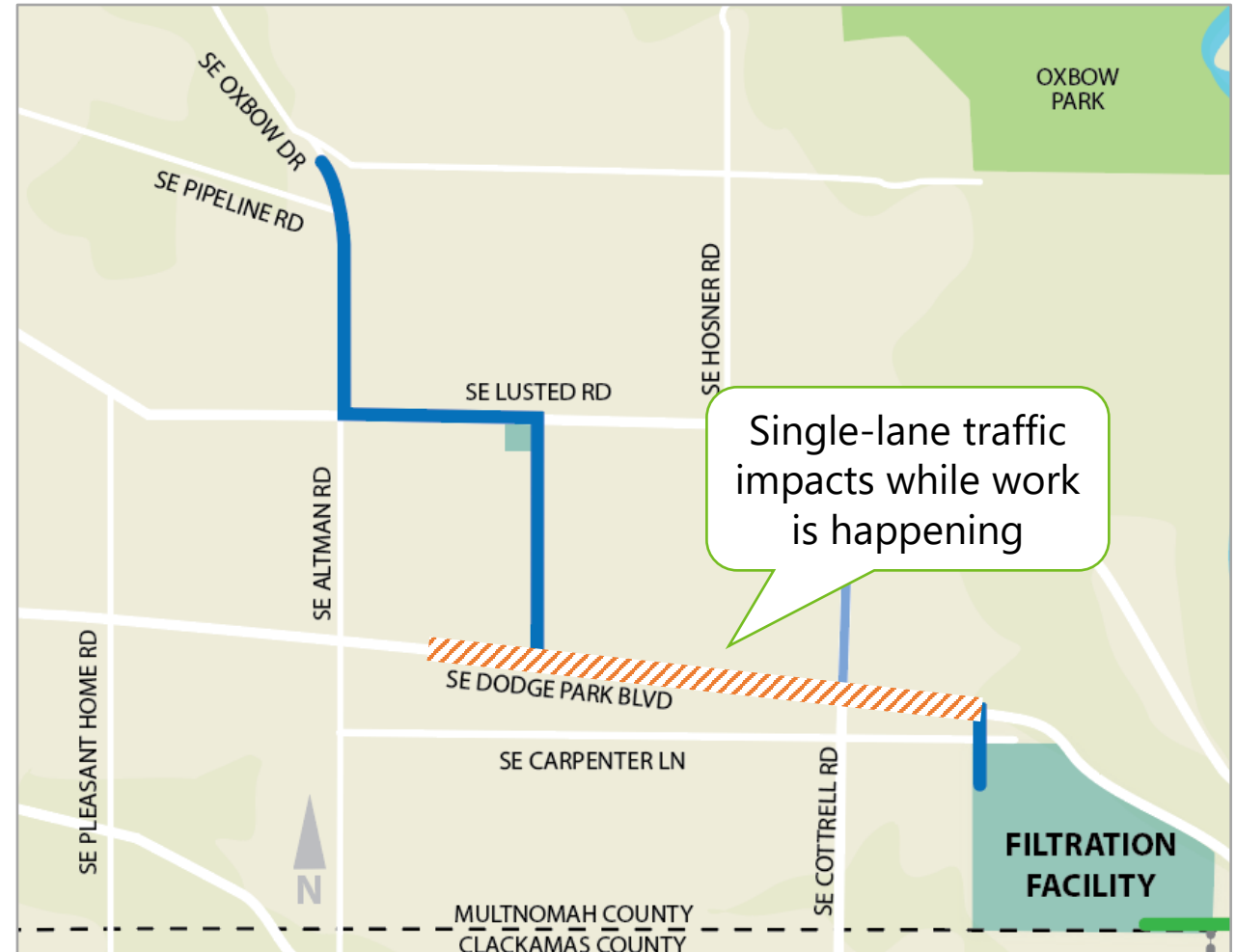
- One new pipe from facility will follow Dodge Park, then cross easement to intertie
- New pipes from intertie will follow "upper" Lusted, then Altman to tie in near Pipeline and Oxbow with existing conduits

FINISHED WATER PIPELINES

Dodge Park Blvd pipeline work



- Installing large-diameter pipe in south side of right-of-way
 - 300+ ft of pipe already installed
- Expect traffic controls and flagging during shift hours through October
- Also planning Dodge Park Blvd/ Cottrell Rd intersection closure in October

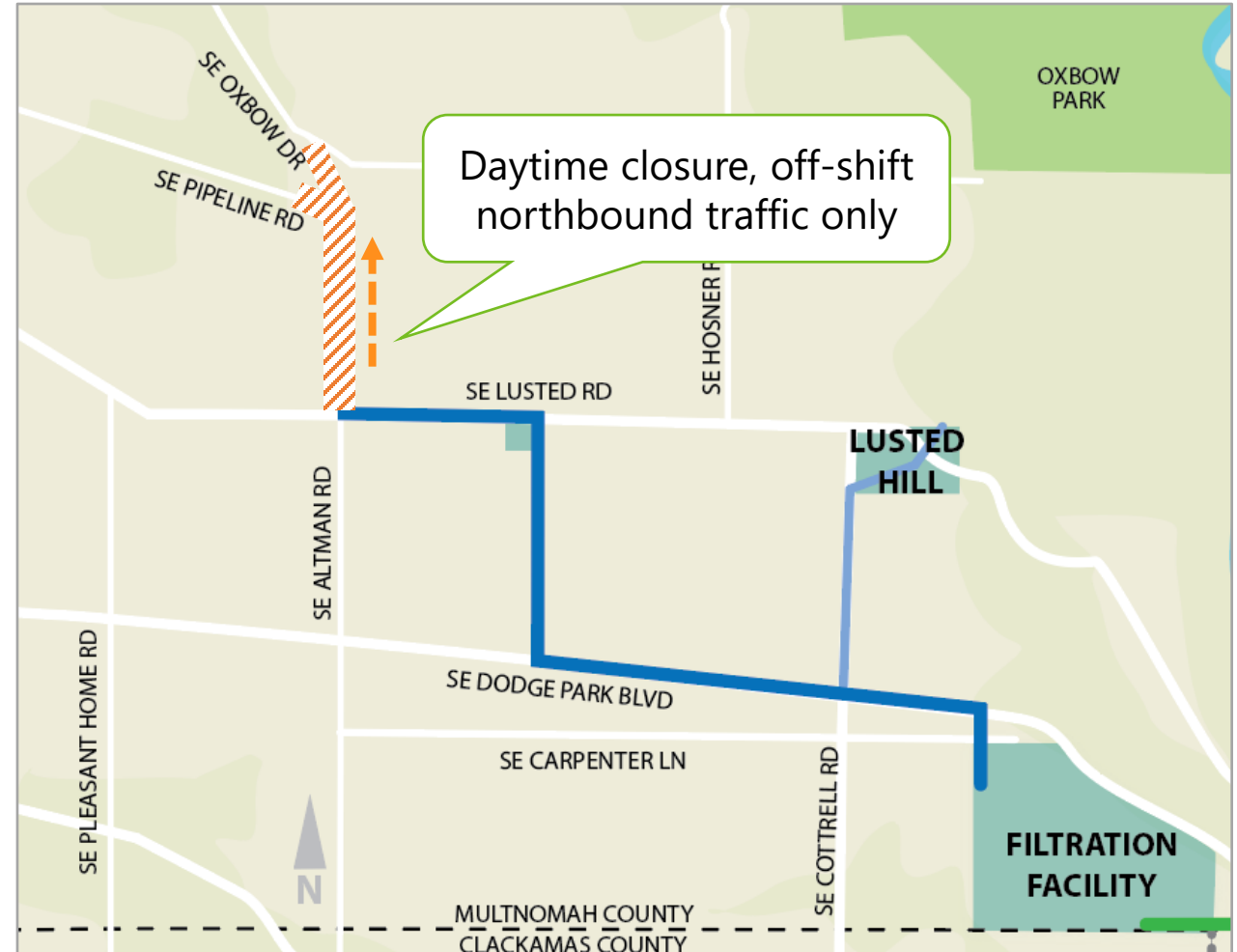


FINISHED WATER PIPELINES

Altman Rd closure starting this week



- Estimated work duration through end of October
- Signed detours for through traffic
- Flaggers will maintain access for local residents, school buses, and emergency vehicles
- Off-shift, Altman Rd will be opened to northbound only traffic



Upcoming pipeline work

- **August/September 2025:**

- Ongoing pipeline tunnel work at portal and shaft between Lusted Rd and facility site
- Mobilizing at intertie site off Lusted Rd

- **November 2025:**

- Tunneling new pipeline under Carpenter Ln
- Starting installation of new distribution main in Cottrell Rd
- Starting installation of new pipeline in Lusted Rd right-of-way

- **Spring 2026:**

- Controlled blasting for tunnel excavation at the southeast corner of the facility site
- Extended road closure on Altman Road to install new finished water pipeline



Facility construction overview



JULY 2025

Current Activities

- Underground and concrete encased piping
- Concrete pours for basins and structures (ongoing for 18-24 months)
- Overflow basin construction
- Mechanical and electrical work sitewide

Facility site traffic management and safety

- Increased vehicle traffic to site
- Vanpooling option for craft workers in place
- Temporary offsite signage for traffic routes and notifications
- Street sweeping
- Onsite dust control

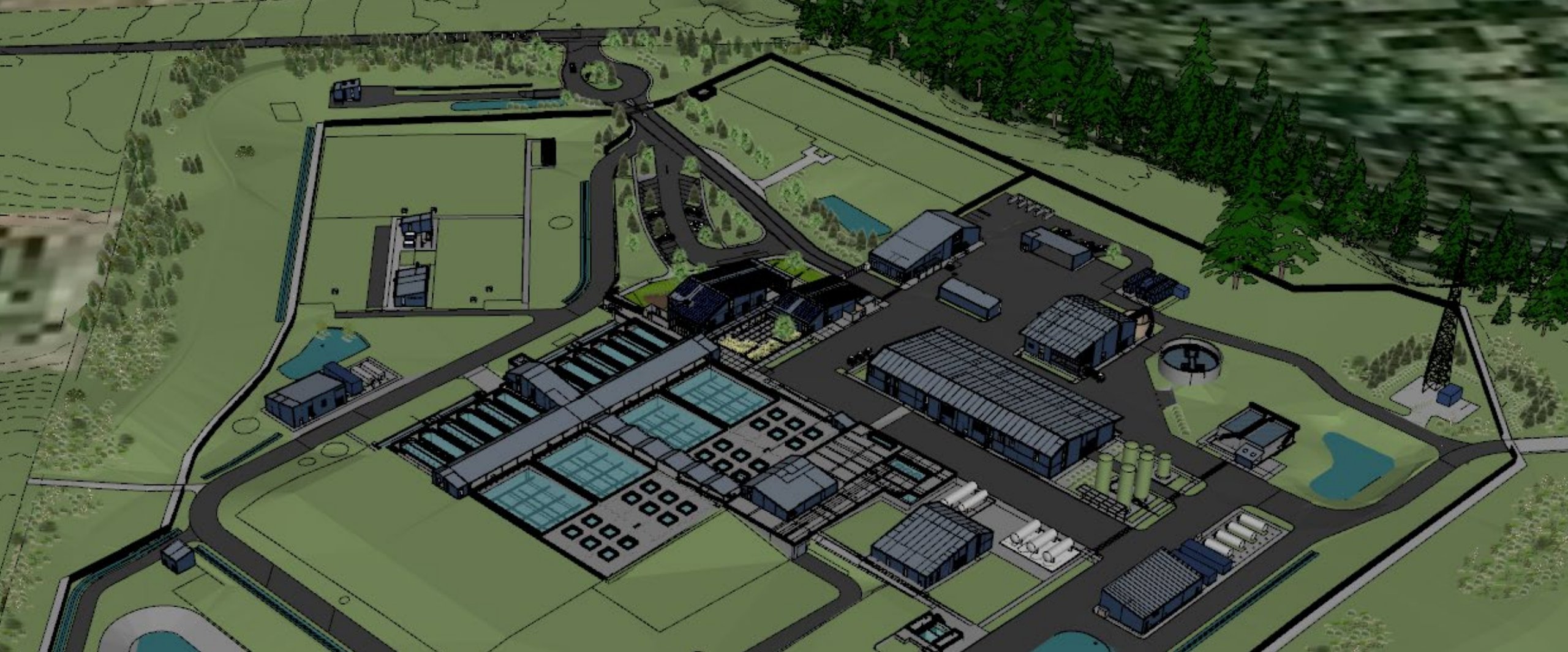
