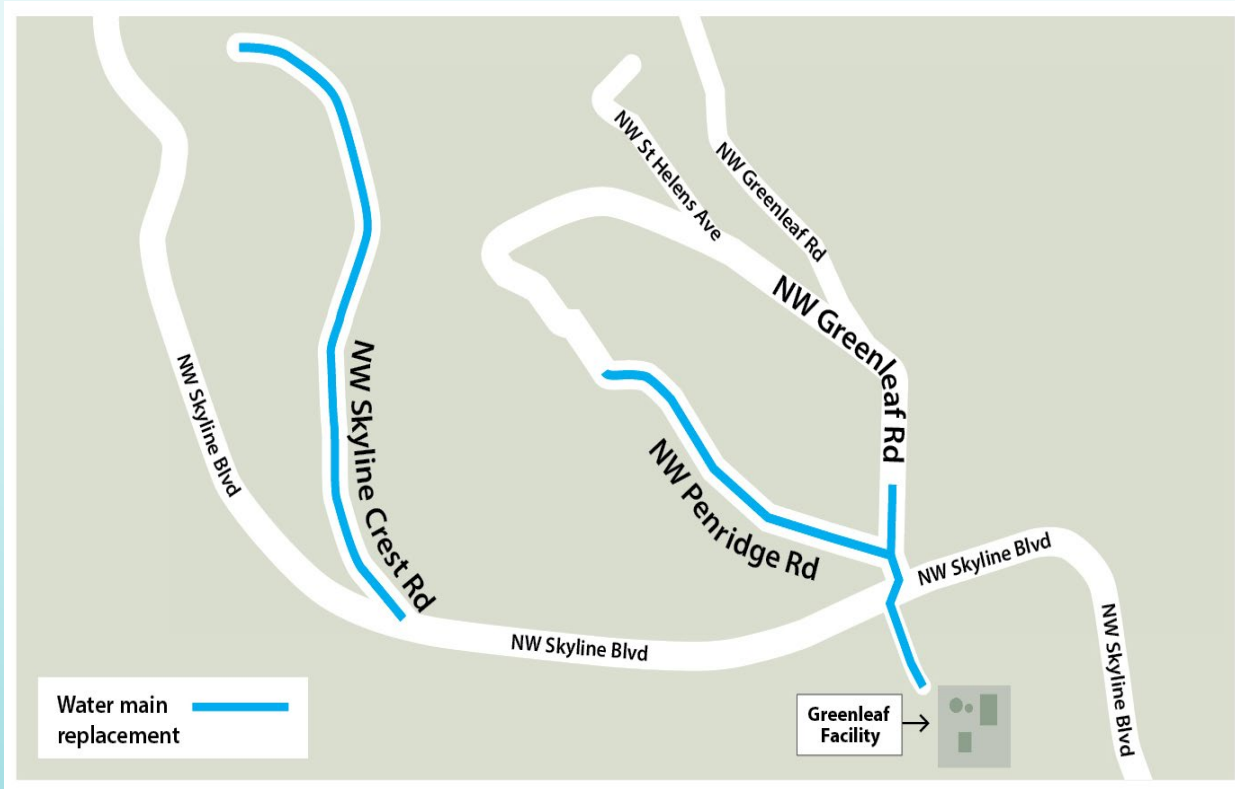

What are we doing?

We're replacing nearly 100-year-old water pipes on:

- NW Skyline Crest Road
- NW Penridge Road
- NW Greenleaf Road
- NW Skyline Boulevard

Why we're doing this

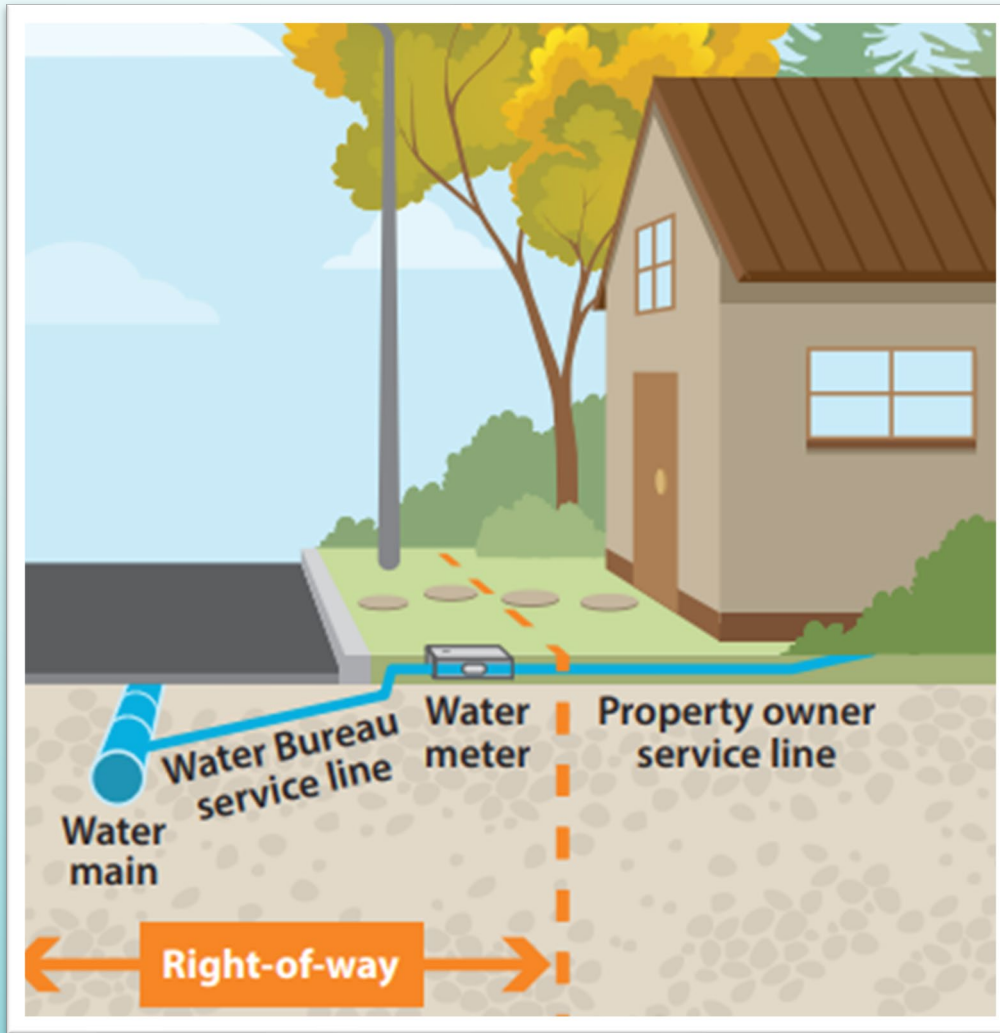




What's happening now

- Project out to bid: contract will be awarded soon
- Construction is expected to begin in early 2023 and will last 12 months

Pre-construction activities



Right-of-way clearance

- We will need to work in the public right-of-way adjacent to your property
- We may ask you to remove items surrounding our water meter or in the public right-of-way

Tree trimming











- Trees will be trimmed 15 feet above the road surface before construction
- A certified arborist will supervise the work
- Tree protections will be in place



Survey and utility locates

- We will identify right-of-way boundaries, existing underground utilities, and other landmarks

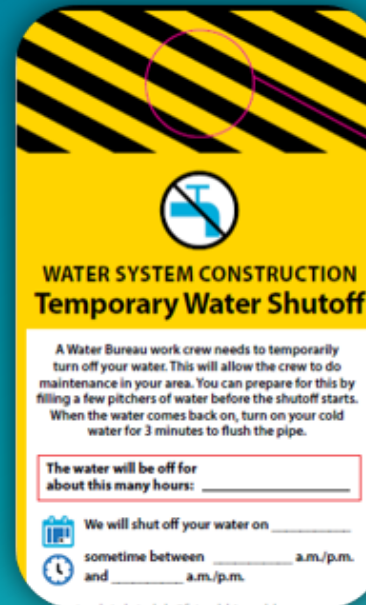
Survey color markings and what they mean

	Proposed excavation
	Temporary survey markings
	Electric power lines, cables conduit and lighting cables
	Gas, oil, steam, petroleum or gaseous materials
	Communication, alarm or signal lines, cables or conduit
	Potable water
	Reclaimed water, irrigation and slurry lines
	Sewer and drain lines

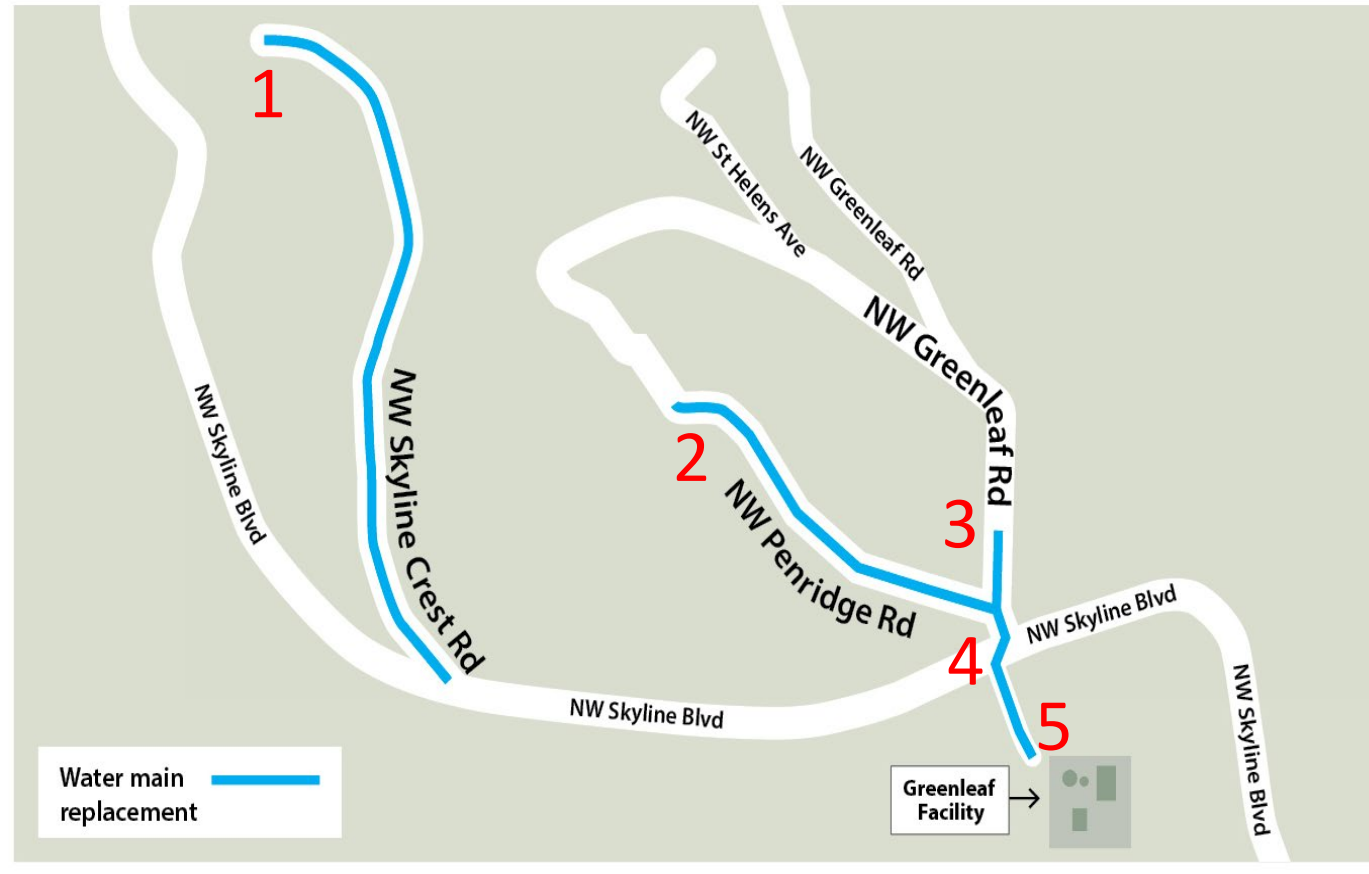

Steps for replacing a water main



Work in phases





Noise and dust

- During construction work hours, you can expect noise and dust.
- You may hear cars driving over steel plates in the road before we finish repaving the street.

Traffic delays

- Plan ahead and give yourself extra time.
- Talk to construction workers to let them know if you need driveway access.
- Portions of some streets will be closed during active construction. You will have to park in the road a few houses down from where you live.
- Mail and delivery will have access.



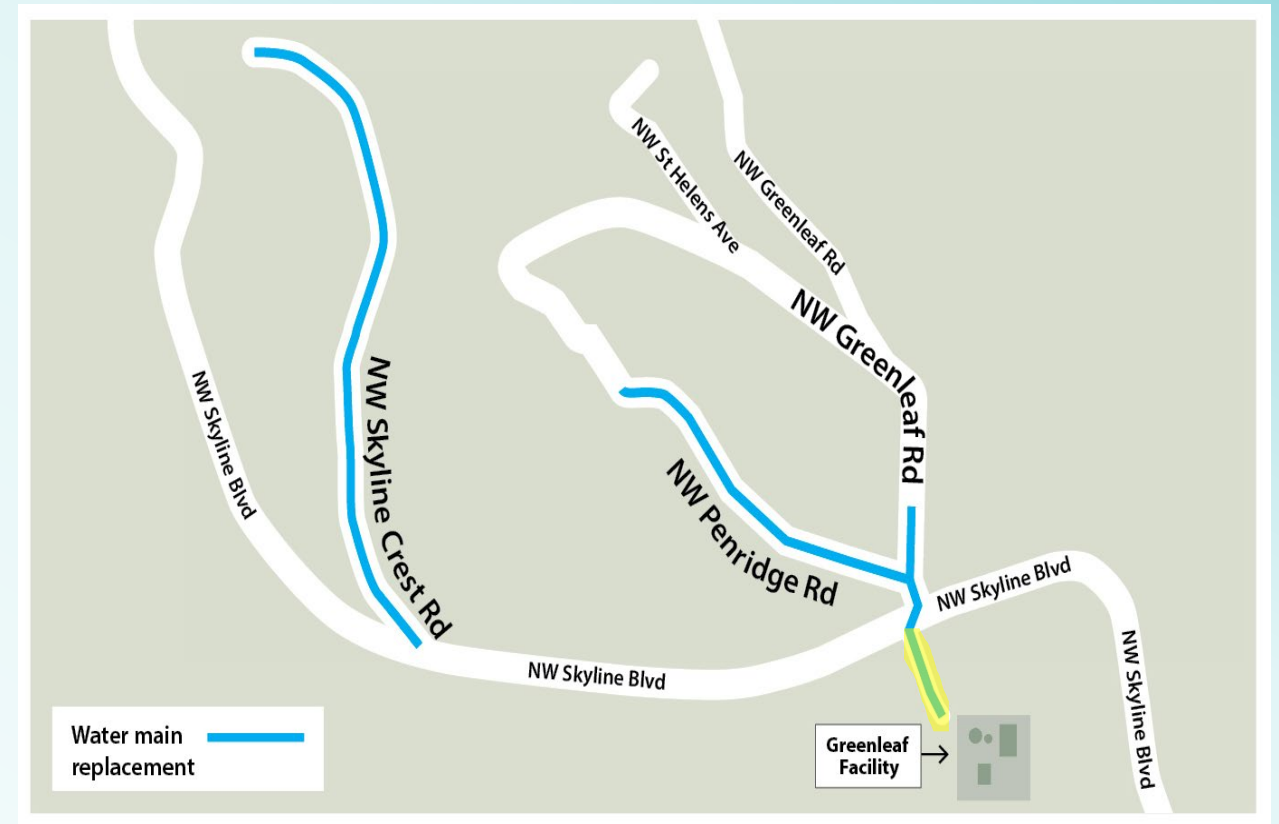


Access needs

- Narrow streets leave little room to get around
- Check your mail for access survey
- Contractor will designate access concierge for Greenleaf south of Skyline

Work on the south side of Skyline

- Work in this section will require a full daytime road closure on workdays
- Your neighbors may need to park on the north side of Skyline
- We have contacted and met with neighbors to discuss access
