



Tree Location: Plan




Tree Location: Side View

- 1. Trees must be a minimum of 5 feet from the nearest edge of water pipe, valve or meter box, water sampling station, and a minimum 10 feet from a fire hydrant.
- 2. Tree selection must be approved by the City Forester.
- 3. Trees to be planted 10 feet or less from any of the facilities listed in Note 1 must be a species expected not to exceed 12-inch diameter breast height (DBH) at maturity. Trees expected to be greater then 12-inch DBH at maturity shall be planted a minimum distance of ½ the root protection zone from water facility trench section. The root protection zone is 1 foot radius from the center of the tree trunk per inch of the tree diameter (DBH) at maturity. See Detail 1, Tree to Trench Distance.
- Distribution pipe trench section is pipe outside diameter plus 18-inches for pipe size <16-inch and outside diameter plus 24-inches for pipe size ≥16-inch, See P-815.



Detail 1: Tree to Trench Distance
