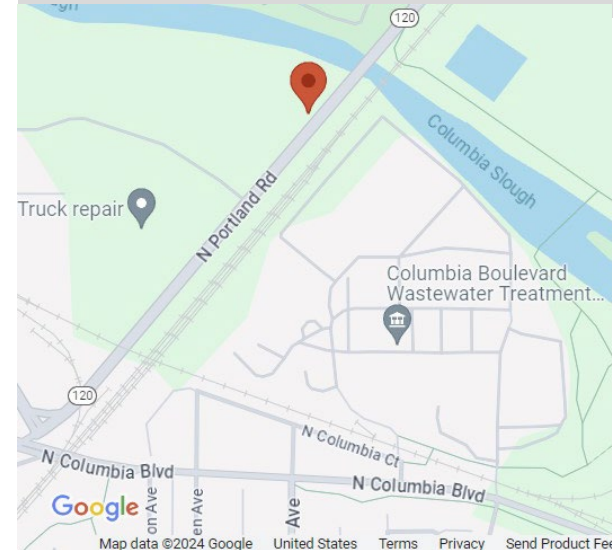

Temporary Alternative Shelter Sites provide secure shelter with 24/7 staffing where residents can access mental health support, substance use disorder treatment, and other critical resources as steps towards permanent housing. TASS is one component of the County and City's Homelessness Response Action Plan.
